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Material Sourcing

Colorman has an enduring commitment to the responsible sourcing of materials for our products. This commitment extends to ethical considerations where decisions are made in good conscience and in the context of known or questionable issues.

Material due diligence

To ensure the minerals in our products are responsibly sourced, based on our suppliers' efforts to identify and address risks in their own operations.

Conflict Minerals

Colorman complies with all national and international legislation on conflict materials which includes commitment to the Dodd-Frank Act.

Planet

Colorman wishes to protect the environment. We work to divert waste from landfills, reuse and recycle materials, and conserve our planet's precious resources; and we continued our efforts on fighting climate change.

We work to minimize our impact on the planet is to reduce the amount of waste generated while manufacturing our products. We look to identify safer green alternatives. To better understand the opportunities for greener alternatives, we examine which chemicals are used in our final assembly facilities and evaluated all control measures.

Colorman expects our supplier to proactively monitor their environmental impacts through policies and programs that conserve natural resources, reduce greenhouse emissions, eliminate waste, reuse and recycle materials, promote purchase of sustainable products and services and promote sustainable construction and building modifications.

Biodiversity

We work at maintaining biodiversity by responsible disposal of our wastes, specifically paper/board (removed for recycling), chemicals (removed by hazardous waste specialists), waste minimisation through software/design, control of our emissions (trade effluent/air/noise), protection of local waterways (Royal canal, Tolka river), essentially being good neighbours and protecting the environment for the next generation by always making the right call at our own expense.

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
